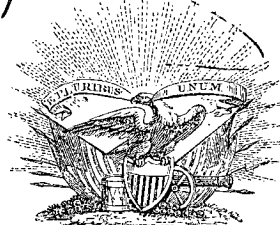

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 16803 for 160 acres, issued in favor of

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the

*West half of the North East quarter and the West half  
of the South East quarter of Section Seven, in Township  
one <sup>south</sup> of Range Thirty West, in the District of Lands  
subject to Sale at Tallahassee Florida containing  
one hundred and fifty nine acres and seventy five  
hundredths of an acre*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL:

Robertson*

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said

*John M Robertson*

the Tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *John M Robertson and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
